AOC Bordeaux

The deep crimson colour is accompanied by powerful notes of blackcurrant and black cherry mingling with just a gentle hint of liquorice. The all-round impression is medium body and good roundness. With its low acidity, it is smooth and rich with a long finish.

Location : Bordeaux

Total surface area of the vineyard :
200 hectares

Soil:

South/south-east facing clay-limestone plateaux.

Vine varieties for the Sainte Foy Bordeaux :

Merlot 35%, Cabernet Franc 30%, Cabernet Sauvignon 35%. 2010 Vintage.

Vinification and maturing:

Maceration for one week before fermenting in order to extract the primary aromas. This is followed by alcoholic fermentation under temperature control at 30°C - 32 °C (approx. 86°F).

Average production :

100 000 cs/12
