### Rheinhessen Pinot Noir Rosé

<b>Variety:</b>	Pinot Noir Rosé
<b>Origin:</b>	<p>Rheinhessen, Germany</p> <p>The Rheinhessen region is Germany's largest wine growing area with a more than thousand-year-old tradition. Vines are grown along the rolling hills of the Rhine River. Rheinhessen enjoys the climate of a protected basin. It is an area with some of Germany's warmest and driest climate. Overall, it has low precipitation, warm summers and mild winters. These perfect conditions allow Rheinhessen grapes to grow to their full potential.</p>
<b>Vintage Note:</b>	<p>After a mild winter and a cold spring followed by a very humid summer we experienced a beautifully warm late summer and dry autumn with perfect harvesting conditions. 2016 vintage turned out to produce fruit driven, very accessible wines with excellent structure and ripeness.</p>
<b>Winemaking:</b>	<p>Grapes from selected vineyards have been chosen to produce this Pinot Noir Rosé. Gentle pressing, strict purification of musts, fermentation with selected yeasts under temperature controlled conditions, storage in stainless steel tanks until bottling.</p>
<b>Wine Analysis:</b>	<p>Alc. 12.0 % vol. Residual Sugar 4.0 g/l = 0.4 % Acidity 6.5 g/l</p>
<b>Winemakers Tasting Note:</b>	<p>Flower Garden shows typical flavours of a Pinot Noir Rosé from the Rheinhessen region. It is loaded with red berry aromas, such as cherry and strawberry and it has a fruity soft finish.</p>
<b>Food Matches:</b>	<p>Try this Pinot Noir Rosé with tapas and snacks or simply enjoy on its own.</p>
