Appellation:	Region: Pfalz Country: Germany
Varietals:	Riesling 100 %
Vineyard:	Bordered by Rheinhessen on the north and France on the south and west, the Pfalz's vineyards sweep across this remarkably pretty, peaceful land for nearly 50 uninterrupted miles. It is Germany's second largest wine region in acreage. It is second only to the Mosel in acreage planted with the noble Riesling grape. Over 20% of the all Pfalz vineyards are planted with Riesling.
Analysis:	Alcohol 10.5 % vol. Residual Sugar 22.4 g/l = 2.24 % Acidity 7,0 g/l pH 2.97
Vinification:	Fermented with selected yeasts in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks.
Tasting Notes:	Lots of exotic fruit aromas, rich in clean fruit flavors. With a fuller middle palate which is nicely balanced by ripe acidity. Very crisp finish.
Food Accompaniment:	Enjoy with favorite Asian, Indian or Fusion cuisine. Also very enjoyable with light starters.
