Packaging:

Another beautiful edition from famous watercolourist Heinz Ames, who uses Riesling as his medium. The Wehlener Sonnenuhr is named after the Sundial ("Sonnenuhr" literally means sundial) erected in the vineyard in 1842 by Jodocus Prüm, an ancestor of J.J. Prüm, to give the workers a better time orientation.

Winemaking:

This 100 % Riesling wine from the Mosel-region was fermented and stored in stainless steel, temperature controlled and bottled cold sterile.

Analysis:

Vintage:	2014
Alcohol:	ca. 10.0 % vol.
Residual sugar:	ca. 29.7 g/l
Acidity:	ca. 7.5 g/l

Tasting note:

Fine, fruity Riesling bouquet, well-balanced palate, hint of exotic fruit, very crisp, refreshing and straight forward.

Serving suggestion:

It goes well with salads, chicken dishes and Asian cuisine, and can of course be enjoyed on its own as an easy drinking summer wine or aperitif.

Next to an enjoyable wine this is also an excellent gift. Serve slightly chilled.
