Following the French Revolution in 1789, the biggest Burgundy estates have been shared in several "Estates" and auctioned, which will change significantly the landscape of the French vineyards.

In 1805, the Dubois family, coming from Paris, was one of the first family to buy vineyards in Burgundy, and the birth of Louise Dubois in 1885 was the beginning of a new adventure for our company.



This **Pinot Noir** develops fruity aromas along with woody notes. Supple and pleasant in mouth, this wine is well-balanced and delicate. The final is ample with a great bouquet of red fruits.

Wine & food pairing: This Pinot Noir can be greatly associated with white meat such as veal or poultry, duck but will also be perfect with tuna or salmon.
