Following the French Revolution in 1789, the biggest Burgundy estates have been shared in several "Estates" and auctioned, which will change significantly the landscape of the French vineyards.

In 1805, the Dubois family, coming from Paris, was one of the first family to buy vineyards in Burgundy, and the birth of Louise Dubois in 1885 was the beginning of a new adventure for our company.



This **Cinsault-Grenache** reveals a bright pink color. The nose offers delicate aromas of raspberry and strawberry. In mouth this rosé is very well-balanced with both red fruit and freshness. The final is long and elegant with spicy notes.

Wine & food pairing: This rosé can be enjoyed as an aperitif or during a meal. It will be beautiful during the summer with a barbecue or seafood.
