California Chardonnay



A grand Queen Anne Victorian style home located just a short walking distance from the historic Sonoma Plaza, in Sonoma, California. The Bancroft family began construction of the site in 1896 and by 1906 called it their home. One of the many prestigious visitors to this estate, General Vallejo, gave the gift of a pepper tree to the Bancroft family, (a symbol of luck); this tree still stands, as a stately figure, on the grounds today, 786 is rich in history and folklore.

Region:

With warm sunny days moderated by cooling influences, conditions in these areas create an ideal climate for growing Chardonnay. Grapes harvested from a variety of vineyards and areas are able to provide unique flavor components that together create a balanced, complex and harmonious wine.

Tasting Notes:

Rich aromas of apple, pineapple and guava jump from the glass providing all the notes and nuances of warm-climate Chardonnay. Bright citrus flavors on the palate give way to sweet spice notes with more stone fruits on the finish. The palate is both rich and full-bodied, with bright acidity that carries through to the very end.
