

Ich bin ein Weisswein 2018 Qualitätswein Rheinhessen

Variety: Blend of Silvaner, Müller-Thurgau, Bacchus and Riesling

Origin: Rheinhessen
The Rheinhessen region is Germany's largest wine growing region. Its beginnings go back to the Romans who already planted vines along the banks of the Rhine River. Varied soils and the favourable climate make it possible to grow many grape varieties, old and new.

Vintage Note 2018 was an exceptionally warm and dry year. Few occasional rain showers end of summer were very welcome. The harvest conditions were simply perfect and grapes were picked at excellent ripeness levels. The wines are charmingly aromatic, fruit driven and very well balanced.

Winemaking: Gently pressing, strict purification of musts, fermentation with selected yeasts under temperature controlled conditions, storage in stainless steel tanks until bottling.

Wine Analysis: Alc. 11 % vol.
Residual Sugar 16.0 g/l
Acidity 6.0 g/l

Winemaker Tasting Note: Fresh and fruity, medium bodied with aromas of Meyer lemon, pineapple and apricot.
