

2018 Cat Bottle Pfalz Pinot Noir Rosé Qualitätswein

Variety:	Pinot Noir Rosé
Origin:	<p>Pfalz, Germany</p> <p>Bordered by Rheinhessen on the north and France on the south and west, the Pfalz's vineyards sweep across this remarkably pretty, peaceful land for nearly 80 uninterrupted kilometers.</p> <p>It is Germany's second largest wine region in acreage, but often has the largest crop of all. The word Pfalz is a derivation of the Latin word palatium, meaning palace.</p> <p>Modern technology and viticultural training have made their mark here in the past four decades. Yet for the visitor driving through the sea of vines along the German Wine Road, the scene is still pastoral with the tree-covered Haardt mountain range, castle ruins, fruit trees, and old walled villages of half-timbered houses.</p>
Vintage Note:	<p>2018 was an exceptionally warm and dry year. Few occasional rain showers end of summer were very welcome. The harvest conditions were simply perfect and grapes were picked at excellent ripeness levels. The wines are charmingly aromatic, fruit driven and very well balanced.</p>
Winemaking:	<p>To produce this Rosé grapes from selected vineyards have been chosen. Grapes were pressed immediately after crushing and were fermented with selected yeasts in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks until bottling.</p>
Wine Analysis:	<p>Alc. 12.0 % vol. Residual Sugar 7.0 g/l = 0.7 % Acidity 7.0 g/l</p>
Winemakers Tasting Note:	<p>This crisp and fresh Pinot Noir Rosé is lively with cherry and strawberry aromas. It offers a great taste experience.</p>
Food Matches:	<p>It goes very well with starters, white meat and pasta. Serving temperature: 8-10°C</p>
