**Moselland Von Großen Lagen
Riesling Trocken Qualitätswein**

Variety: Riesling

Origin: Moselland Von Grossen Lagen is made from specially selected grapes grown in classified Grand Cru sites of the Middle Mosel region.
The blend consists of 60% of grapes grown in the world-class Lieserer Niederberg-Helden and 20% each of grapes grown in the Ürziger Würzgarten and Graacher Himmelreich vineyards.
Each vineyard site has its own, highly individual character. This wine combines the best of the three vineyard sites.

Vintage Note 2018 was an exceptionally warm and dry year. Few occasional rain showers end of summer were very welcome. The harvest conditions were simply perfect with grapes harvested on four occasions from Sep. 20 to Oct. 6 at perfect ripeness, which makes the wine very intense and rich, yet fruity and extremely structured.

Winemaking: Grapes were visually inspected on perfect healthiness prior to pressing. After gentle pressing musts were spontaneously fermented in small, temperature controlled stainless steel tanks without use of cultivated yeasts until mid April 2019. After a 3-months sur-lie storage the individual lots were filtered and blended shortly before bottling, which took place July 01, 2019, followed by another 2-months-storage in bottles before release.

Wine Analysis: Alc. 12.0 % vol.
Residual Sugar 5.0 g/l
Acidity 7.0 g/l

Winemaker Tasting Note: Aromas of citrus, grapefruit and apple with a mineral touch. Zesty and well balanced with seamless crispness this wine has an elegant structure. It finishes dry with mouthwatering length.

Food Matches: Enjoy with white fish, seafood and light dishes. Serve well chilled.
