Nahe Riesling Qualitätswein

Variety: Riesling

Origin: Nahe, Germany
The Nahe region is named after the river that traverses the valleys of the forested Hunsrück Hills until it joins the Rhine River in Bingen. Although the Nahe is one of the smaller German wine regions, its extraordinary range of soil types is second to none. For this reason, the region is able to produce quite diverse wines from relatively few grape varieties. Grapes for this Riesling grow on soils mixed with fine, weathered slate and quartzite.

Vintage Note: Weather conditions were quite exceptional, from a late-frost-incident, several heat waves during the summer months to occasional rainfall during harvest time. Thanks to efficient vineyard management during harvest and determined winemaking this 2019 vintage proves to be of very high quality at comparatively low quantity.

Winemaking: Grapes from selected vineyards have been chosen to produce this Riesling. Gentle pressing, strict purification of musts, fermentation with selected yeasts under temperature controlled conditions, storage in stainless steel tanks until bottling.

Wine Analysis: Alc. 10.0 % vol.
Residual Sugar 32.0 g/l = 3.2 %
Acidity 7.0 g/l

Winemakers Tasting Note: This fine Nahe Riesling has a perfect balance of fruitiness and crispness with hints of exotic fruits. A refreshing experience.

Food Matches: It ideally pairs with grilled fish, salads, light Thai-food, chicken and any kind of white-meat-dishes.
Serve well chilled.
